## Financial Administrator's Message

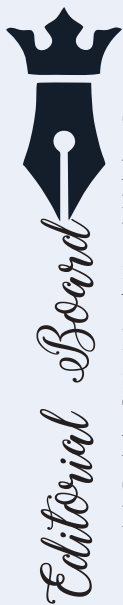
### LUMINARIES

## EXAMINATION PATTERN

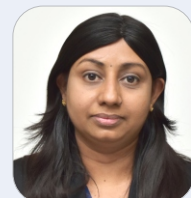

So, in order to inculcate a regular teaching-learning education system and to develop a regular study pattern in the young minds, we are introducing a transformed system for conducting the examinations to reduce the burden and exam fear among the students and also to build a rational learning spirit.*

**New Assessment Pattern** for the Academic year 2022-23.

There will be **2 terms** in a year and **2 cycles** of tests per term.

- Two tests will be conducted in a week- one test will be on **Tuesday** and other test will be on **Friday**.
- Each **Students' Achievement Test (SAT)** will be conducted for **20 Marks (Class 1 to 4)** and **25 Marks (Class 5 to 10)** and **Term Achievement Test (TAT)** will be conducted for **40 Marks (Class 1 to 4)** and **80 Marks (Class 5 to 10)**.

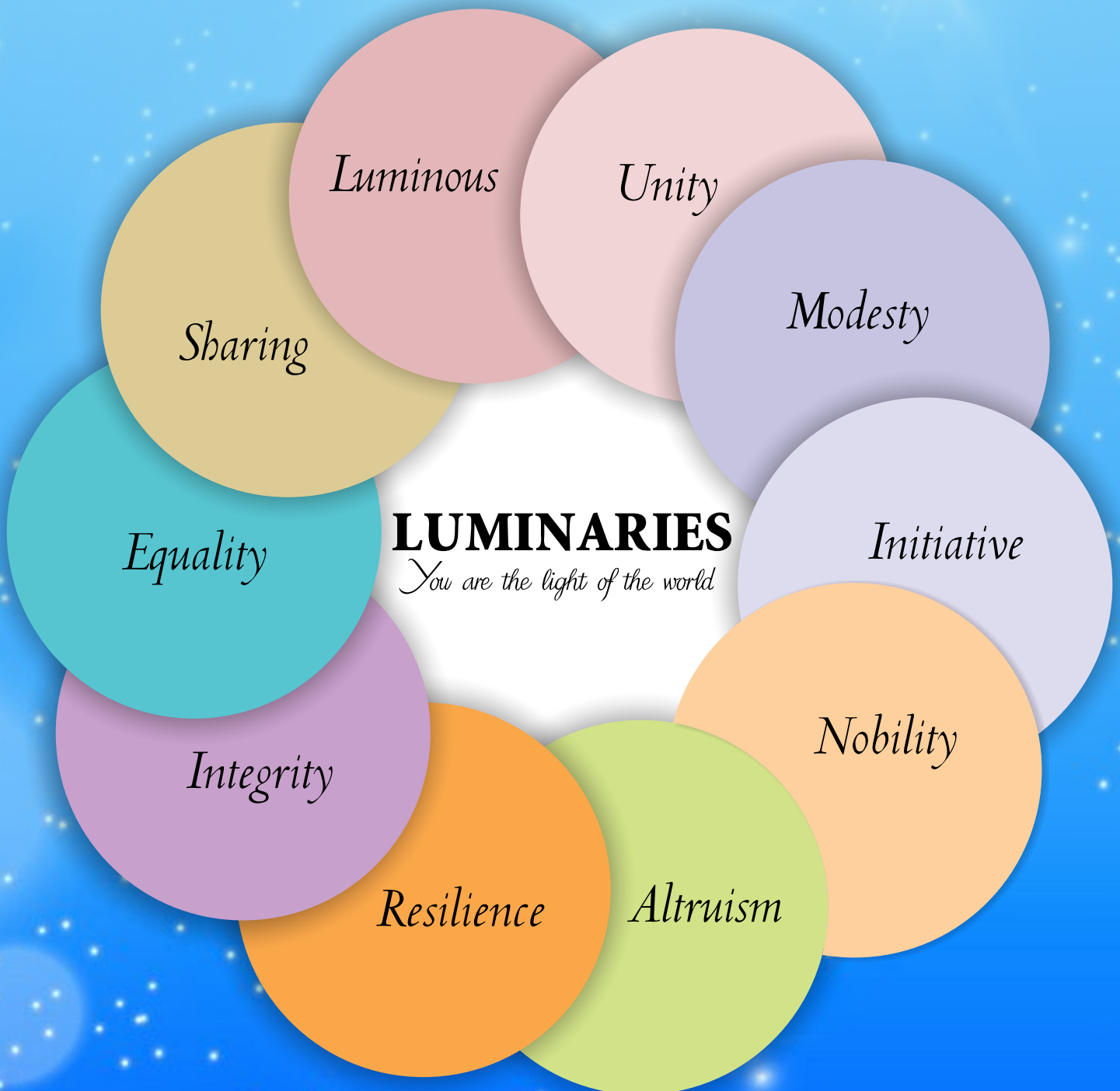


# LUMINARIES

## FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

*Never stop learning, because life never stops teaching.*

Teachers of CHRIST SCHOOL ICSE had a two days session on MINDFULNESS; TEAM WORK & COMMUNICATION by an extraordinary and exceptionally skilled trainer Mr. Justin Thomas, **ISSTAC [Institute of Soft Skills Training and Counseling]**.

A person full of energy and enthusiasm, Mr. Justin Thomas is Psychologist, Trainer, Life Coach, Author and Speaker. For the last 15 years he has been focusing on training programs based on Soft Skills and Life Skills, MIND POWER, Outbound and Neuro-Linguistic Programming across the world. He has conducted around 4000 training and counseling sessions in his career (both online and offline).

Mr. Justin holds a few national recognitions, certifications in training and counseling, various work experiences, awards and also has good educational qualifications from well-established institutions across the nation.

Teachers' were divided into eight groups. The session began with a question to be analyzed on the issues that hurdle a teacher's performance. This activity aimed at being a mindful teacher. Next few activities were based teamwork. Thumb rules for teaching process to be followed by a teacher. We need to use a technique to teach!





The next day's session started with the concept of seven elements for effective communication. This was followed by a positive affirmation in which a set of points were displayed which were expected to be read by a teacher every day. Each team were given limited time to come up with a teaching aid. We were also made to write our shortcomings as a teacher on post-it and through this each one had to take a decision to become a better teacher. A blind fold activity was done on both the days to build in team work and trust among teachers.

Take away points:

- ▲ We need to be a mindful teacher.
- ▲ Team work is better than group work.
- ▲ Use a technique to teach.
- ▲ Follow thumb rules for teaching process.
- ▲ I should consider all my students special.
- ▲ Being with children is an art-we need to learn this.
- ▲ Being ecologically right – what you think, say and do should be correct to you and others.
- ▲ Teacher has to be a good counselor.
- ▲ If a child is not getting the topic, give extra time and teach them.
- ▲ Don't be involved in politics rather involve in teamwork.
- ▲ A teacher is supposed to be an actor / actress.
- ▲ Sharpen your skills as a teacher.
- ▲ Duty of a teacher to identify the skills and talents of your students and help them to excel in it.
- ▲ Inspire the students to be better human beings.
- ▲ Be an effective communicator.
- ▲ Bound in negative thoughts. Use Shut-up method. Claim this when you are bound with continuous chains of negative thoughts – Shut up and get out.
- ▲ Talk something good about your students.
- ▲ Correct the students in private and appreciate in public.
- ▲ Don't discuss the negatives of your students with colleagues.

The training sessions were fun filled, interactive and activity based with lot of learning for us as teachers. We are indeed grateful to the Principal Rev. Fr. Nilson Davis, CMI and the management for inviting an eminent resource person for the second time to conduct fruitful sessions.

He delivered his speech underlining the two important term that should be remembered in your life: Truth and Compassion.

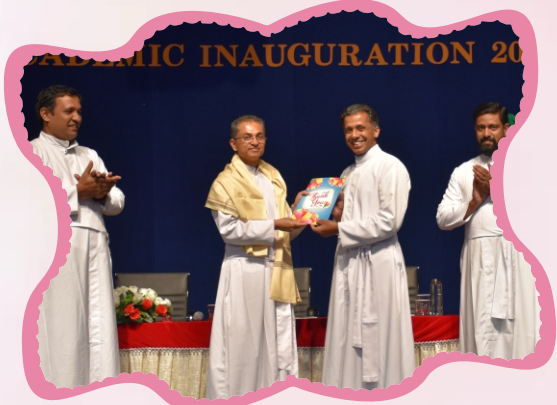

# Health and Hygiene- Webinar for Girls

“Adolescence is just one big pimple.” -Carol Burnett

To educate young girls on the subject and explore the otherwise unspoken aspects, Christ (ICSE) School held a seminar on "Menstruation." Dr. Kavita Peter Gonsalves, a seasoned gynaecologist, working at Rainbow hospital in Bangalore, participated as the seminar's host. On June 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, respectively, high school girls in grades 8, 9, and 10, and middle school girls in grades 5, 6, and 7, attended the sessions. Several themes dealt with the fantasy of growing, including adolescence, puberty, menstruation, hygiene, obesity, UTI, tobacco, drugs, and alcohol. Let me share the mantra with you- “Exercise, healthy lifestyle and a balanced diet” is the key to prevent maximum number of diseases. Dr. Kavita covered the least-discussed topics of PCOS and no menstruation while emphasizing the positives. In an exposed society, we frequently debate whether the period-fighting method—“sanitary napkins/ tampons/ cloth/ menstrual cups/ discs/ washable cloth pads”—is better. The best choice is to converse with oneself through body talks and discover what the body feels comfortable in. As young ladies, we would have discussed this with our peers. After a genuinely insightful and thought-provoking session, Dr. Kavita was non-judgmental, allowing space for queries. Her attitude rubbed onto our skins the fearlessness to normalize the 'P-word.'
